Meeting called to order: President Kathi Obendorfer, recognizing a quorum, called the meeting to order at 5:38 p.m.

Approval of Annual Minutes: Jim Schepers, (Secretary), read the minutes from the 2/13/2023 Annual Meeting. A motion to approve was made by Deb Osburn, seconded by Leslie Brown, and passed unanimously.

2. Officer Reports

President Report: Kathi Obendorfer began by thanking everyone in attendance and remarked this was the largest Annual Meeting that she could recall. She remarked that she felt this was a result of the various community events the organization had recently performed and the positive response from the community. The Halloween Safe Walk was well attended, and everyone seemed to have a great time. The Christmas Street Parade was once again a huge success and a big thank you to the community for their generosity. The OEVA website was updated with a donation button and over \$8,600 was contributed. This was accomplished by Eric Peterson, and he was introduced to most everyone earlier in the evening. He has agreed to chair the I.T. Committee for 2024. The money raised allowed the organization to give 64 bikes to the Englewood youth and

cover the expenses associated with the event. She again thanked everyone for their support of this project.

She recapped the various events that OEVA sponsored throughout the year, Cruisin on Dearborn, Seafood Festival, Halloween Safe Walk and the Christmas Event and expressed confidence that we could do this again for 2024.

She expressed hope for an increase in membership this year and encouraged those in attendance to go to the website and join by volunteering and joining the organization.

She then recognized Les Bernstein for his past 6 years serving on the Board. Les had been a driving force in most of the events that took place at Pioneer Plaza before the County updated the facility, Due to the by-laws, a director cannot serve more than 2 consecutive 3-year terms and must take a year long absence. He will be missed this year.

She then turned to Leslie Brown and thanked her for the last 2 years of service. Leslie chaired many committees these last couple of years and she also was a reason for the recent success of the organization.

Vice President's report: No report.

Treasurer Report: Joyce Colmar - The Treasurer provided an annual report about the account balances of the organization. She began by talking about the budget for 2024. She estimated that total income for 2024 would be about \$24,000 and based on past experience, expenses would be \$19,527 with a net income of \$4,464.37. The organization also has a certificate of deposit for \$25,000.

Secretary Report: Jim Schepers – The Secretary reported that 3 seats are available for filling this year. They are seats 1, 2 & 3. Currently, seat # 1 is filled by Joyce Colmar; #2 by Les Bernstein, # 3 by Leslie Brown, #4 by Kathi Obendorfer, #5 by Jim Schepers, #6 vacant. Seat # 7 was filled by John Majka who was elected last year for a 3-year term last year. Seat #8 is filled by Deb Osburn and seat # 9 by Terry Shortt. Their terms expired 12/31/2026. Leslie Brown has decided not to run for reelection to seat #3. The election for this year will be under New Business.

Jay Henderson was recognized for an announcement for the Annual Boat Show. He said the Boat show would be returning to Englewood on November 15,2024. The expect another great show.
